

## MMS Band Booster Meeting Notes – Dec. 8, 2009

The meeting was called to order by President Mikulay.

The Treasurer's report was given. There is \$5701.44 in the general fund, but that includes \$2018.17 in student funds and monies not yet forwarded for the Spring Trip. We expect about \$800 from the Apple Festival. \$850 is the actual amount in the general fund.

November minutes were accepted. Amy Johnson made the motion to accept and was seconded by Jennifer Phillips.

In covering old business, we were reminded that the Market Day pick up date is Dec. 14<sup>th</sup>. Angie Peterman is the MMS contact for Market Day, and Pam Gilmore is the MHS Market Day contact. Pam Grob is in charge of the SIU Concession fundraisers. Sign up for the SIU concessions is online through the Band Booster website. There were 13 participants in the Poinsettia Fundraiser. Our profit will be 20% of \$800 or \$160.

Mr. Williams left the director's report. There are 46 students participating in the Spring Trip which is April 29<sup>th</sup> to May 2<sup>nd</sup>. Chaperones have already been notified. The next installment payment is due Dec. 11<sup>th</sup>. The Holiday Concert is Tuesday, Dec. 15<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm. Students are to wear concert dress to school for the daytime performance and bring clothes to change into. Parents please check concert dress prior to the evening performance, just in case..... Pep Band performances are mandatory and part of the students' grade.

New business discussion included a reminder that donations for the baskets to be raffled off are due now. Volunteers were sought to sell raffle tickets at the door the night of the concert. All unsold tickets and money are due Monday, Dec. 14<sup>th</sup>. There was some discussion about the Mardi Gras Fundraiser. Volunteer signup sheets were passed around with the next planning meeting to be held Jan. 12<sup>th</sup> at 6 pm (prior to the Band Booster meeting). Band Boosters voted to give Mr. Williams a \$50 gift certificate.
